Free parking is available in the North Car Park which is accessed via the entrance on Rugby Road. (The West Car Park is now a 'fan village'). Also park in the North Car Park if you are staying at the Marriott.

Access to the venue on foot is via the Lion Gates (now also called the Rose and Poppy gates – see photo) to the Spirit of Rugby on the second floor of the West Stand.



For those who have booked the coach, this will leave the club at 6.15pm and will collect you from Twickenham at 1.00am.

The bar will be open from 7.00pm and the drinks reception, with access to the Royal Box overlooking the floodlit stadium, will be held between 7.30pm – 8.00pm. This is paid for in your ticket so don't be late!

Should you wish to purchase wine/drinks to have with your meal it is recommended you buy this prior to the drinks reception & place on your numbered table.
